Orphanage

We are happy to inform you that our former PRO at the Edo Orphanage home in Nigeria, Mr. Shedrack Aims Ikharo is now the PRO for all 22 orphanage homes in Edo State. He was appointed in March 2010 as an executive officer of the National Association of Orphanage homes, Vulnorable Children and NGOs. He is one of the six representatives of Edo State at the Federal level in Abuja, the capital of Nigeria.Mr. Shadrach Aims Ikharo With a Diploma in social work, B.sc in Sociology and a Masters in Theology was promoted on the 08-09-2010, to the position of Manager. He is now the manager of FESH Complete package in Nigeria. Taken into fact that Nigeria is a country of over 150 Million people and 17.5 % of Nigerians are Orphans , we have indeed come a long way in having one of our own person at the top.

There is an on going case with four dimensions as I write this report.

- 1. An official of an orphanage home is currently in court for embezzling money meant for our children.
- 2. An official of another orphanage home has been declared wanted by the police for misappropriation of fund.
- 3. An official of yet another orphanage home is in court for murder
- 4. An official is facing prosecution for selling human parts.
- 5. And finally, a proprietor of a home for orphaned children has been prosecuted for selling children and making young orphaned kids surrogate mothers for rich people who can't have their own.

The four dimensions are as follows:

Embezzlement.

Selling of human parts

Rape (orphaned girls used as baby making machines for the rich)

Murder.

In all of these cases apart from Number 5, our former PRO Mr. Shadrach Aims Ikharo, now our manager, was instrumental to the discovery and prosecution of those involved. We therefore decided to empower him the more by promoting and employing him permanently as the manager in our sister organization, Food, Education, Shelter and Health (FESH Complete package) in Nigeria.

Conclusion:

We gave clothes and shoes to 90% of the orphanage homes in Edo State. They were all presented with two bags each. The donations were collected by staffs and proprietors of the home.

The remaining 10% has been asked to come and collect their own bags of clothes and shoes at our Skill Acquisition center in number 11 Agho Street off Ekewan road Benin City.

Without your encouragement and help, we would not have been able to fish out and prosecute those people who were stealing, abusing orphaned girls, selling human parts and using orphaned girls as surrogate mothers for the rich.

This dirty business that has been in the dark all this years, only came to the open because people like you did not give up in supporting Gods work on earth. Without you, there would have been less and the less they have, the more brutal they get in their evil deeds. It is the too much you placed on their table that makes you want to know why the tables are empty and why there is no sign of progress after a hundred years of Africa begging and receiving from your generosity.

I beg you in the name of God and humanity! Do not stop to help these children and the vulnerable!! When Good people stop being good, Evil takes over.

HIV/AIDS has proven to us that, there is know hiding place or safe haven.

Most orphaned kids without mentors, ends up as prostitutes or criminals.

A prostitute + murderer or long distance driver = Another orphaned child.

Orphaned child + lack of a proper home = Abused orphaned child.

Abused orphaned child + lack of love and mentor = Criminally abused orphaned child.

Criminally abused orphaned child + Luck = Adventuristic criminally abused orphaned child.

An adventuristic criminally abused orphaned child = Hate of a standing order, Europe, America, Asia will feel them in form of prostitutes, drug dealers, criminals and God forbidden terrorists. There is no hiding place from them apart from Heaven.

Do not be discouraged, continue to do more good in order to protect mankind.

Project Chad:

We promised to help the people of Chad and that we will do.

Our report on the survey that was conducted by our team, the UN and African team on IDPs in Chad is out. It took us a year to release it because the report is originally in French and I needed our team to translate it to English. The three officers I employed to handle the project in 2007 during my last mission to Abeche, Chad, are all from three different French speaking part of Africa. Since Chad is a French speaking country, we needed the people to conduct the survey in the French language and the report was therefore French. Skill Acquisition:

We have successfully established a sewing institute in Benin City. It is situated in number 11, Agho Street, off Ekewan road, Benin City.



We have 30 Male and female students with two teachers on ground (male and female teachers).

Mr. Shadrach is the manager of the school and he reports to Professor S. E. Orobator and Professor L. A. Atsegbua directly. The school is about 90 square meters, 35 sewing machines and materials for learning. The cost of learning is free and we will provide them with one warm meal a day after the first six months.

The training fee is zero! And students will have their own sewing machines and store when they finish. That is why we are called FESH Complete package!! We will not stop half way.

The school was officially commissioned by the Prime Minister of Benin Kingdom, Chief Nosakhare Isekhure the Isekhure of Benin Kingdom.

Health:

AUFAD e. V. Germany started her annual First Aid Seminal this year. The Seminal that lasted three days was directed at motor circle transport association (Okada riders) because of the high accident rate and death in that occupation.

During the three days, participants were shown what to do in an emergency event involving them, their members, family and members of the public.

Mr. Godwin Ogbebor, a member and volunteer by the Johanniters International, is a lecturer on First Aid, Primary and Preventative Health. He personally led the course assisted by two other members of FESH.

In these three days, food, water and writing materials were provided to the 105 participants. They came from all the 18 local Government areas of Edo state. The seminal was held at their state headquarters in number..... Ekewan road Benin City. On completion of the three day seminal, participants were given their certificates

We will be going back next year for a month's course during which we will pick the best 36 people from all the 18 local government areas representing Edo State, they will be trained as trainers in First Aid. These people shall form the arrow head of the interior areas of Edo State. They will all be tested and given certificates at the end of the course.

Other news:

Our service office in number 105, First East Circular road, Benin City, has been upgraded to our Headquarters in Africa. It takes immediate effect.

The flat of almost 80 square meters was donated by Professor S. E. Orobator for free. He equally offered to pay the secretary from his own purse. Professor S. E. Orobators financial commitment to FESH Complete package now stands at about 1500 EURs. a year. He equally donated the equivalent of 200 EURs. On the day of the commissioning.

- He is a senior advocate of Nigeria.
- He is a professor and majors in seven disciplines.
- He retired this year as the Dean of Faculty for Social Science at the age of 69 and remains on contract with the University of Benin.
- He is an author of books in conflict and crises resolution.
- He was sworn in as the Chairman for the Independent Corrupt Practices Commission (ICPC) Uniben on the 28-09-2010.

Our Secretary General Professor L. A. Atsegbua has been promoted to the Dean of Faculty for Law at the Federal University of Benin. Though he was not physically present at the commissioning of the FESH School of fashion, his foot prints were visible to those of us who know him.

I wish to dissuaded anybody or group of persons who misunderstood his absence as vacancy to stop flaunting their CVs. I am equally using this opportunity to beg those who parade themselves as the Sec. Gen. to FESH foundation to stop henceforth or face legal consequence.

Professor L. A. Atsegbua was promoted about three months ago to his current position as the Dean of Faculty, Law. The workload and responsibility attached to his office is enormous to say the least.

The reason for his absence is the goodness of his federal presence.

Conclusion:

Mr. Ifeanyi...... Has know hands and know legs. Please donate to us a wheel chair or your financial support to make life worth living for him. He spent over three days with us in our office in Nigeria and it was heart breaking for him when other people started collecting their prosthesis and he got nothing. He has attempted suicide several times and failed, he was crying when he explained to me about his inability to leave his world of torture. We promised to make an appeal for fund on his behalf to God fearing, human loving and people with conscience, like you. Please help us not to disappoint him.



Mr. Ifeanyi.....no legs and no hands. His dream and prayer is for death to come, unfortunately, death sturbonlly refuses to cooperate with him. When he asked to know why death refused him, I told him it is because you received him. Please don't let him remain like this.

We are now having four staffs and two offices taking care of 30 students, over 60 amputees and organization of our activities. Please help us to keep them on our payrole, it is easy to corrupt a person that works without incentives.

Knowledge is worthless unapplied and useless after death. The only thing that stays forever is knowledge delivered to enable others. Those of you who are professionals are hereby challenged to stop being selfish with your skills. Acquiring more knowledge is not greed, it only becomes a tool for evil, if you let people live and die in ignorance despite your ability to change things for the better.

I urge you all to take heed from what we are doing in AUFAD e. V. let people around you be an extension of yourselves.
